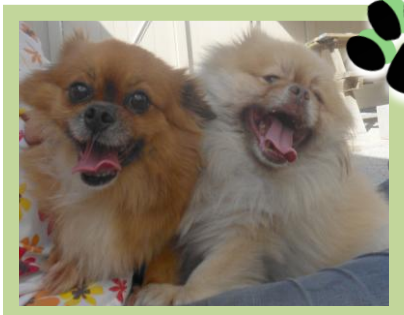

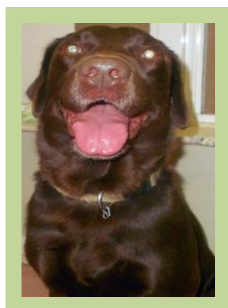
Living the Dog's Life in Their FURever Homes
